

Designed to give Club Directors of venues in NSW with gaming machines, options to meet gaming reform training requirements.

The course is a one-hour abridged version of the Advanced Responsible Conduct of Gambling (ARCG) course, equipping Club Directors with a high-level understanding of their venue's responsibility to minimise gambling harm.

The course is Liquor & Gaming NSW approved. Please be advised that a Certificate of Completion will be issued by the college which must be retained on file as evidence of completion and available for inspection.

To be compliant, Club Directors of venues with gaming machines in NSW must have completed either:

- the Responsible Conduct of Gambling (RCG) and Advanced Responsible Conduct of Gambling (ARCG) training courses or
- a Responsible Gambling Board Oversight (RGBO) training course approved by L&GNSW.

#### PREREQUISITES: NIL

Note: RGBO training does not include a NSW competency card endorsement.
